



DARK BEER

<p><u>TROUBADOUR OBSCURA</u> 8.5% £6.50</p>	<p><i>Loaded with toasted malt, coffee and chocolate aromas and flavours, with just a little sweetness.</i></p>
<p><u>STRAFFE HENDRIK</u> <u>QUADRUPLE</u> 11% £7.00</p>	<p><i>With raisins, sultanas and spices on the aroma, on the tongue it has a big rum-like central taste before a dry bitter hop finish.</i></p>
<p><u>GULDEN DRAAK</u> 10.5% £7.00</p>	<p><i>A dark and strong Belgian ale with hints of cherry, plums and sweetened coffee.</i></p>
<p><u>MALHEUR 12</u> 11.5% £7.00</p>	<p><i>This dark chestnut-coloured beer releases a delightful bouquet of spices and rich hop flowers and has a full-bodied flavour.</i></p>
<p><u>PANNEPOT</u> 10% £7.00</p>	<p><i>Old Fisherman's Ale is a dark ale brewed with spices. Pannepot is a term that describes the Fishing Boats from the village of De Panne.</i></p>
<p><u>ENAME DONKER</u> 6.5% £6.50</p>	<p><i>With aromas of caramel and sweet fruit, the taste of toasted malt, coffee, dark chocolate, and bitter hops right down to the dry finish.</i></p>
<p><u>GULDEN DRAAK</u> <u>9000 QUADRUPLE</u> 10.7% £7.00</p>	<p><i>A fruity aroma, with a smooth and slightly sweet flavour, the secondary fermentation ensures a shelf life of several years with continued flavour evolution.</i></p>

WIT-BIER

<p>La TRAPPE WIT 5.2% £6.50</p>	<p><i>The world's first and only white Trappist ale that continues to ferment slightly after bottling. A real thirst-quencher on a hot summer's day that also makes for a delicious drink at any other time of the year.</i></p>
<p>HOEGAARDEN 4.9% £4.50</p>	<p><i>The original wheat beer. Almost 600 years ago, in the Belgian village of Hoegaarden, a band of monks experimented by adding oddball botanicals from half way around the world to their traditional wheat beer. The final creation is a beer with a refreshing flavour and captivating aroma, unlike any in the world!</i></p>

RED BEERS

<p><u>CHIMAY RED</u> 7% £6.50</p>	<p>The initial taste is sweet, while the dark malt holds in place the finishing touches of burnt chicory and toasted bread.</p>
<p><u>CAROLUS CLASSIC</u> 8.5% £6.50</p>	<p>After lengthy maturing and conditioning, it is bottled unfiltered, giving a beer which is rich in vitamins and 100% natural.</p>
<p><u>KEIZER KAREL</u> 8.5% £6.50</p>	<p>Top fermented ruby red beer with a mild and fruity flavour and a sweet hoppy aftertaste.</p>
<p><u>CORSENDONK PATER</u> 6.5% £6.50</p>	<p>With delicate hints of toasted malts and with fruity notes emerging on the finish.</p>

BLONDE

<p><u>DE RANKE</u> <u>GULDENBERG</u> 8% £6.50</p>	<p>A full-bodied abbey beer that balances between sweet and bitter. It is dry-hopped with Hallertau Mittelfrüh which results in a unique soft-bitter taste and aroma.</p>
<p><u>La CHOUFFE</u> 8% £6.50</p>	<p>With peaches, apricot and citrusy touches on the nose it has a more herbal flavour, combined with sweet malt before a crisp finish.</p>
<p><u>MALHEUR 10</u> 10% £7.00</p>	<p>Full bodied, medium strong, gold coloured beer, with a rich honey-like texture, and a pleasant warming, slightly hoppy-dry lingering aftertaste</p>

<p><u>HOMMEL BIER</u> 7.5% £6.50</p>	<p>A full and refreshing palate shifts to mild citrus, orange and grapefruit, in combination with the hops. The sweet honeyed finish combines a slightly spicy flavor of cumin, ending with a nice kick of hops.</p>
<p><u>CHIMAY WHITE</u> 8% £6.50</p>	<p>It is golden in colour, and succeeds remarkably in blending mellowness and bitterness.</p>
<p><u>OUDE</u> <u>QUEZE BOON</u> 7% £6.50</p>	<p>This Lambic beer is aged for 1, 2 or 3 years in oak casks. The blend, a mild average 18 months old Lambic (unsweetened, unfiltered, unpasteurised) is refermented in the bottle and can be stored up to 20 years. Brewed in Lembeek, the village that gave Lambic its name.</p>
<p><u>STRAFFE HENDRIK</u> <u>TRIPEL</u> 9% £7.00</p>	<p>Sweet spices, fruit, honey, bread, gentle citrus, bitter hop edge, warming finish. Like a fairytale it is.</p>
<p>AVERBODE 7.5% £6.50</p>	<p>Resounding, sweet malt and a pleasant hop character by carefully selected hops. A fresh, rich and bitter aftertaste make this (unique) a real beer experience.</p>
<p><u>DUVEL</u> 8.5% £6.50</p>	<p>Four generations of the Moortgat family have brought together Pilsner malts, Bohemian hops, and a unique yeast strain to create this intense, aromatic and beguiling ale. This Belgian favourite is best enjoyed with discerning friends or good-looking strangers.</p>

AMBER

<p><u>KWAK</u> 8.4% £6.50</p>	<p>Pauwel Kwak has earthy aromas, a malty character with touches of liquorice, a nougat-like robustness and a warm finish not unlike caramelised banana.</p>
<p>ORVAL 6.2% £6.50</p>	<p>the Orval Trappist brewery makes only one beer for the general public. It has an intensely aromatic and dry character. Between the first and second fermentations there is also an additional dry-hopping process. Through this the beer acquires its pronounced hoppy aroma and extra dry taste.</p>

<p><u>T'VERZET</u> <u>REBEL LOCAL</u> 8% £6.50</p>	<p>The first sip knocks off with a mild fruitiness, which slowly makes way for a floral, somewhat spicy hoppiness. The aftertaste has a firm bitterness that brings perfect balance to the beer.</p>
<p><u>T'VERZET</u> <u>MOOSE BLUES</u> 7.5% £6.50</p>	<p>With a sweet aroma of maple syrup, the flavours that follow are of raisins, malts & dark fruits with a hint of madeira</p>
<p><u>BUSH</u> 12% £7.00</p>	<p>Bush Ambrée is a filtered, high fermentation beer. It is exclusively made from malt, hops, natural sugar, water drawn from the brewery's basement and exclusive yeast jealously preserved for 65 years.</p>

FRUIT BEERS

<p><u>TIMMERMANS</u> <u>KRIEK</u> 4% £4.50</p>	<p>From the cherry tree's transient flowers, its fruits ripe, round, red and packed with sunshine. Timmermans Kriek blends its famed lambic with this sweetness for a beer that can quench any thirst. Its natural freshness will make you blush for joy.</p>
<p><u>TIMMERMANS</u> <u>FRAMBOISE</u> 4% £4.50</p>	<p>Framboise is made by adding 100% natural raspberry aromas to lambic. After maturation in oak barrels, the beer turns a delicate shade of pink that is sure to delight you. Timmermans Framboise is a beer to be savoured with finesse and elegance.</p>
<p><u>DELIRIUM RED</u> 8.5% £6.50</p>	<p>A soft aroma of almond and sour cherries (girottes), and tastes tangy and fruity, with a perfect balance between sweet and sour.</p>
